Dear SCFGPA Members:

On behalf of the SCFGPA Board, I want to inform you of the details regarding the impending range improvement construction which is beginning.

First, I want to thank all the members who have volunteered their time over these past years working diligently on the planning phase of this project. It has been quite a lot of work and preparation to bring this project to fruition. Founded in 1921 and housed at our present location since the early 1960's, we have much nostalgia and history to be proud of, and many of us years of memories of having grown up learning about shooting and proper gun handling. When completed we will have an upgraded and modernized range at our disposal with many of the amenities found on gun ranges in 2019.

As was explained at the September 4 general meeting, contracts have been finalized and dates firmed up as to the beginning of construction. The available start dates to clean the range and clubhouse of lead and for the construction to start were given to us by the contractors just this past Wednesday.

As of this weekend, September 7, the construction project will begin. All of the facilities will be closed to members while the lead cleanup phase is in progress. Signs will be posted. **PLEASE DO NOT** enter the clubhouse or range until further notice. We need the lead cleanup to go smoothly and without any contamination by traffic. The faster the cleanup, the faster the construction proceeds, the faster we get our range back up and functioning.

As was also stated Wednesday, we will keep you advised of the availability of the use of the clubhouse area once we are told by the construction manager it can be safely utilized.

Attached to this mailing you will find a flyer from Tactical Training Center LLC. The owners at TTC were kind enough to offer our members an exclusive membership opportunity to take advantage of during the next few months should you want to shoot somewhere in our immediate area. Thank you TTC.

Finally, thank you all for your patience during this process. This has been a long time in coming and although at times it seemed as if it was not moving forward as quickly as possible, I do want to remind everyone that all of the process, from the very first mention of re-constructing the range years ago up to this week, was done on volunteer time. Thank you all for your patience and concerns over these past months of planning and discussions. Patience is truly a virtue and I am proud to serve you as president during this special time in our club's history.
